

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF  
THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF ARAB, ALABAMA  
FEBRUARY 4, 2019**

The City Council of the City of Arab, Alabama, met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. for its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, February 4, 2019, in Arab City Hall, the time and place scheduled for such meeting.

Mayor Bob Joslin called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the following answered present:

Also present were Tony Willis (City Clerk), Rodney Edmondson (City Attorney), several city department heads, representatives of the media and the public.

Mayor Joslin declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for the transaction of business. Council Member Harper led the pledge of allegiance. The invocation was given by Council Member Allen.

The minutes of the January 22, 2019, regular meeting were approved by unanimous vote upon a motion made by Council Member Allen and seconded by Council Member Warren.

Mayor Joslin then reminded the Council of all items and department head reports which had been covered during the work session.

With no more staff reports or old business, Mayor Joslin then moved to the first item of new business, three (3) board appointments on the Industrial Development Board. Mayor Joslin opened the floor for nominations for the three positions. Council Member Harper nominated Mr.

Clint Maze. Council Member Hart moved to close the nominations. Council Member Allen seconded and all voted yes. Upon roll call, Council Members Hart, Gullion, Allen, Warren and Harper voted yes to appoint Mr. Maze. Council Member Hart then nominated Mr. Tommy Harris for the second Industrial Development Board appointment. Council Member Allen moved to close the nominations. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes. Upon roll call, Council Members Hart, Gullion, Allen, Warren and Harper voted yes to appoint Mr. Harris. Council Member Warren then nominated Mr. Wendell Mead for the third Industrial Development Board appointment. Council Member Allen moved to close the nominations. Council Member Harper seconded and all voted yes. Upon roll call, Council Members Hart, Gullion, Allen, Warren and Harper voted yes to appoint Mr. Mead. Mayor Joslin then declared Mr. Maze, Mr. Harris and Mr. Mead appointed to the Industrial Development Board based on the vote of the Council.

With no more new business to address, Mayor Joslin then opened up the floor for public comment. Ms. Kimberly Hickok stated she lives on Old Cullman Road and appreciates the Council taking traffic issues on that road seriously as discussed in work session. Since no one else sought recognition, Council Member Allen moved to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Harper seconded and all voted yes.
