

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF
THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF ARAB, ALABAMA
APRIL 15, 2019**

The City Council of the City of Arab, Alabama, met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. for its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, April 15, 2019, in Arab City Hall, the time and place scheduled for such meeting.

Mayor Bob Joslin called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the following answered present:

Also present were Tony Willis (City Clerk), Summer Bixler (Administrative Assistant), Rodney Edmondson (City Attorney), several city department heads, representatives of the media, and the public.

Mayor Joslin declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for the transaction of business. Council Member Warren led the pledge of allegiance. The invocation was given by Council Member Gullion.

The minutes of the April 1, 2019, regular meeting were approved by unanimous vote upon a motion made by Council Member Allen and seconded by Council Member Hart.

The Mayor reminded Council of pre-meeting report and items covered during the work session.

With no more staff reports or old business, Mayor Joslin then moved to the first item of new business, a motion to approve to move the next meeting of the Arab City Council to

Monday, May 13, 2019. Council Member Gullion moved to approve the motion. Council Member Allen seconded and all voted yes.

Next, the second item of new business, one (1) board appointment on the Board of Education. Mayor Joslin opened the floor for nominations. Council Member Warren nominated Mrs. Judy Collier. Council Member Harper moved to close the nominations. Council Member Hart seconded and all voted yes. Upon roll call, Council Members Hart, Gullion, Allen, Warren and Harper voted yes to appoint Mrs. Collier. Mayor Joslin then declared Mrs. Collier appointed to the Board of Education based on the vote of the Council.

Next, the third item of new business, a resolution to approve bid specifications for the purchase of a used crawler dozer from Thompson Tractor Co., Inc. in the amount of \$88,000 for the Arab Landfill. Council Member Allen moved to suspend the reading of the resolution. Council Member Hart seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Allen moved to suspend the rules. Council Member Harper seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Hart then moved to approve the resolution. Council Member Warren seconded and all voted yes.

With no more new business to address, Mayor Joslin then opened up the floor for public comment. Since no one sought recognition, Council Member Allen moved to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Harper seconded and all voted yes.
