

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF

JUNE 3, 2019**

The City Council of the City of Arab, Alabama, met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. for its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, June 3, 2019, in Arab City Hall, the time and place scheduled for such meeting.

Mayor Bob Joslin called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the following answered present:

Mayor Joslin declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for the transaction of business. Council Member Harper led the pledge of allegiance. The invocation was given by Council Member Allen.

The minutes of the May 20, 2019, regular meeting were approved by unanimous vote upon a motion made by Council Member Allen and seconded by Council Member Warren.

Mayor Joslin then moved to staff reports. Mr. Eric Hayes with the Arab Park and Recreation Department reported the “dive-in” movie was a success and baseball will be beginning soon. Mayor Joslin reported for Ms. Melissa Cook that they have two developers who are visiting the City as a result of their recent trip.

With no more staff reports, old business, or new business to address, Mayor Joslin then opened up the floor for public comment.
