

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF

The City Council of the City of Arab, Alabama, met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. for its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, May 2, 2022, in Arab City Hall, the time and place scheduled for such meeting.

The minutes of the April 18, 2022, regular meeting were approved by unanimous vote upon a motion made by Council Member Allen and seconded by Council Member Gullion.


The Mayor then reminded the counsel of reports made during the work session and then moved on to staff reports. The Mayor reported on work proceeding on 12th Avenue project. Ms. Melissa Cook reported for Economic Development on a new potential prospect for the City. Arab Police Chief Shane Washburn reported the new P-25 radios were in and working well. Mr. Dameon Pittenger with the Arab Landfill reported that dozer repairs are ongoing. Mr. Eric Hayes from the Arab Park and Recreation Department reported that Movie at the Soccer Field will happen this Saturday.

With no more staff reports to address, the Mayor then moved to the first item of new business, a resolution to approve GMC Scope of Services for Arab City Park Baseball/Softball Fields renovations.
