

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF
THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF ARAB, ALABAMA
JUNE 6, 2022**

The City Council of the City of Arab, Alabama, met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. for its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, June 6, 2022, in Arab City Hall, the time and place scheduled for such meeting.

Mayor Bob Joslin called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the following answered present:

Also present were Tony Willis (City Clerk), Katie Jones (Administrative Assistant), Rodney Edmondson (City Attorney), city department heads, representatives of the media, and the public.

Mayor Joslin declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for the transaction of business. Council Member Gullion led the pledge of allegiance. The invocation was given by Council Member Allen.

The minutes of the May 16, 2022, regular meeting were approved by unanimous vote upon a motion made by Council Member Allen and seconded by Council Member Gullion.

The Mayor then reminded the counsel of reports made during the work session. Ms. Melissa Cook reported on the new Los Arcos building to begin earlier than expected and the City will need to complete roads and infrastructure soon. Arab Fire Department Assistant Chief Michael Hall reported they still have weather radios to pass out. Mr. Jeremy Yates from the Arab Street Department reported that the State is ready to begin paving Main Street this week. Mr. Dameon Pittenger reported that he is waiting on a part for the bulldozer repair. He also reported that he received 17 new house permits last month.

With no more staff reports to address, the Mayor then moved to the first item of new business, a resolution to approve abatement for 2559 Little Creek Road NW. Mr. Dameon Pittenger described the condition and reported that demolition of the structure was needed to abate the nuisance. Council Member Allen moved to suspend the reading of the resolution. Council Member Stone seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Hart moved to suspend the rules. Council Member Stone seconded and all

voted yes. Council Member Allen moved to approve the resolution. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes.

Next, the Mayor then moved to the second item of new business, a resolution to approve Arab Fire Department Budget Adjustment. Council Member Allen moved to suspend the reading of the resolution. Council Member Stone seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Allen moved to suspend the rules. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Allen moved to approve the resolution. Council Member Stone seconded and all voted yes.

The Mayor then moved to the third item of new business, a resolution to authorize the Mayor to sign contract with Trammell/Allen for Arab City Pool and Budget Adjustment. Council Member Allen moved to suspend the reading of the resolution. Council Member Stone seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Hart moved to suspend the rules. Council Member Stone seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Gullion moved to approve the resolution. Council Member Stone seconded and all voted yes.

The Mayor then moved to the fourth item of new business, a resolution to authorize the Mayor to execute change order agreement with CB&A Construction, LLC with corresponding ACS Board MOU and Budget Adjustment. Council Member Allen moved to suspend the reading of the resolution. Council Member Hart seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Stone moved to suspend the rules. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Allen moved to approve the resolution. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes.

Lastly, the Mayor then moved to the fifth item of new business, to approve bid specifications and authorize bid solicitations for widening and resurfacing 12th Avenue and Main Street. Council Member Allen moved to approve the bid specifications. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes.

With no more new business to address, Mayor Joslin then opened up the floor for public comment. Ms. Tina Sampson questioned the timeline of the Little Creek Road NW abatement. Since no one else sought recognition, Council Member Allen moved to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes.
