

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF  
THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF ARAB, ALABAMA  
AUGUST 1, 2022**

The City Council of the City of Arab, Alabama, met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. for its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, August 1, 2022, in Arab City Hall, the time and place scheduled for such meeting.

Mayor Bob Joslin called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the following answered present:

Also present were Tony Willis (City Clerk), Katie Jones (Administrative Assistant), Rodney Edmondson (City Attorney), city department heads, representatives of the media, and the public.

Mayor Joslin declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for the transaction of business. Council Member Stone led the pledge of allegiance. The invocation was given by Council Member Gullion.

The minutes of the July 18, 2022, regular meeting were approved by unanimous vote upon a motion made by Council Member Allen and seconded by Council Member Hart.

The Mayor then moved on to staff reports. Mayor Joslin reminded the counsel of reports made during the work session.

With no more staff reports or old business to address, Mayor Joslin then moved to the first item of new business, one board appointment on the Arab Housing Authority Board. Mayor Joslin opened the floor for nominations. Council Member Hart nominated to reappoint Mr. Sammy Waldrop. Council Member Allen moved to close the nominations. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes. Upon roll call, Council Members Hart, Stone, Gullion, Allen, and Miller voted yes to reappoint Mr. Waldrop. Mayor Joslin then declared Mr. Waldrop reappointed to the Arab Housing Authority Board based on the vote of the Council.

Next, the Mayor then moved to the second item of new business, a resolution to approve identifying the project for Rebuild Alabama Gas Tax Funds. The Mayor called on City Clerk, Tony Willis, who explained reasoning for this year's plan for adopting the roads at Northridge. Council Member Stone

then moved to suspend the reading of the resolution. Council Member Allen seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Hart moved to suspend the rules. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Allen moved to approve the resolution. Council Member Miller seconded and all voted yes.

The Mayor then moved to the third item of new business, a resolution to approve the One Time Pay Increase (SLRF) Budget Adjustment. Council Member Allen then moved to suspend the reading of the resolution. Council Member Gullion seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Stone moved to suspend the rules. Council Member Allen seconded and all voted yes. Council Member Allen moved to approve the resolution. Council Member Hart seconded and all voted yes.

With no more new business to address, Mayor Joslin then opened up the floor for public comment. Since no one sought recognition, Council Member Allen moved to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Miller seconded and all voted yes.
